Pursuant to 3 V.S.A. § 817(e), the Legislative Committee on Administrative Rules (LCAR) writes to make the standing committees having jurisdiction aware of an issue that arose during its review of the above-referenced rule. Specifically, the economic impact statement submitted with the rule states that the agency will incur significant cost increases as a result of the rule. The committees may wish to consider whether these cost increases will in fact occur and, if so, whether statutory changes could reduce the cost of the rule.

This is also to advise you that, during its meeting of Feb. 16, 2017, LCAR voted to postpone action on the rule until its meeting of Feb. 23, 2017.
