## How Do We Get There?

- Complex can be built in stages, with one or two units coming online every two years until it is complete in 2028
- Savings achieved through closure of CRCF and
  - NWCF and cost of deferred maintenance
  - Increasing federal beds will generate additional revenue

    \$6.1M annualized GF operating costs
  - \$6.1M annualized GF operating cost (depending on opening date)

- Begin construction on future facility, with Forensics wing as first "pod"
- Find location for Middlesex TCR
- permanent 16-bed facility
- Secure funding for Woodside
- Psychiatric beds at UVMMC
