

A person 21 years of age or older may cultivate no more than two mature marijuana plants and four immature marijuana plants.

Personal cultivation may occur only on property:

lawfully in possession of the cultivator or with the written consent of the person in lawful possession of the property; and

must be in an enclosure that is screened from public view and is secure so that access is limited to the cultivator and persons 21 years of age or older who have permission from the cultivator.

Landlords may ban possession or cultivation of marijuana in a lease agreement.

Regardless of how many persons 21 years of age or older reside in a dwelling unit, each dwelling unit is limited to two mature marijuana plants and four immature marijuana plants.

“Dwelling unit” means a building or the part of a building that is used as a primary home, residence, or sleeping place by one or more persons who maintain a household
