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2	Senator Pearson moves that the report of the Committee on Natural
3	Resources and Energy be amended following Sec. 11b, by inserting a Sec. 11c
4	to read as follows:
5	Sec. 11c. REPORT; PLANNING FOR RENEWABLE ENERGY
6	DEPLOYMENT
7	(a) On or before July 1, 2019, the Department of Public Service (DPS or
8	Department) shall submit a report that includes an analysis and
9	recommendations to assist renewable energy developers, electric utilities, and
10	other market participants plan for the deployment of renewable electric
11	generation in a manner that is consistent with the statutory greenhouse gas
12	reduction goals at 10 V.S.A. § 578; the goals, requirements, and programs
13	related to renewable energy set forth or established in 30 V.S.A. chapter 89;
14	and the goals of the 2016 Comprehensive Energy Plan. In the report, the
15	Department shall consider the following:
16	(1) how to encourage the deployment of all types of renewable electric
17	generation while minimizing curtailment of such generation;
18	(2) existing and projected transmission and distribution constraints on
19	the siting of renewable electric generation and how to facilitate meeting the
20	distributed renewable generation and energy transformation requirements of

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1	the Renewable Energy Standard at 30 V.S.A. §§ 8004–8005 in light of those
2	<u>constraints;</u>
3	(3) the role of energy storage;
4	(4) recommended methods to guide where renewable electric generation
5	should be located in the State;
6	(5) recommended methods to guide the location in the State of end users
7	that consume significant amounts of electric energy; and
8	(6) other relevant issues as determined by the Department.
9	(b) Prior to submitting this report, the Department shall provide an
10	opportunity for written submission of relevant comments and information by
11	the public and shall conduct one or more public meetings on the matters to be
12	considered in the report.
13	(c) The Department shall submit the report to the House Committee on
14	Energy and Technology and the Senate Committees on Finance and on Natural
15	Resources and Energy.
