10	owners and operators of electric generation in the area, or both.
11	(b) On and after the effective date of this section through June 30, 2019, the
12	Public Utility Commission shall not accept new applications under 30 V.S.A.
13	§ 248 for electric generation facilities that will interconnect with transmission
14	or distribution lines in the area served by the SHEI, except for net metering
15	systems with a capacity less than 15 kilowatts. The Commission shall
16	demarcate the specific geographic scope of this area. The purpose of this
17	subsection is to allow time for the completion of the submissions required by
18	Sec. 11a of this act and the consideration by the General Assembly in the 2019
19	session of potential solutions to the constraints posed by conditions in the
20	SHEI area.
21	Second: By renumbering existing Sec. 11b (RES rulemaking) to be 11c.

1	Third: In Sec. 28 (effective dates), by striking out subsection (a) and
2	inserting in lieu thereof a new subsection (a) to read:
