14	(B) if the person qualifies for a hunting license, a <u>permanent</u>		
15	combination fishing and hunting license, which shall include all big game		
16	licenses, except for a moose license;		
17	(C) if the person qualifies for a trapping license, a <u>permanent</u>		
18	trapping license; and		
19	(D) if the person qualifies for an archery license, an a permanent		
20	archery license.
