Act No. 134 (H.963). Judiciary; sunsets

An act relating to sunsets related to judiciary procedures

This act extends three sunsets related to judiciary procedures. The act: (1) extends the sunset on changes to the Court Diversion Program that were made in 2017 by one year from July 1, 2020 to July 1, 2021; (2) extends the sunset on the Racial Disparities in the Criminal and Juvenile System Advisory Panel by one year from July 1, 2020 to July 1, 2021; and (3) extends the sunset on the statutes governing use of automated license plate recognition systems (ALPRs) by two years from July 1, 2020 to July 1, 2022.
