This act summary is provided for the convenience of the public and members of the General Assembly. It is intended to provide a general summary of the act and may not be exhaustive. It has been prepared by the staff of the Office of Legislative Counsel without input from members of the General Assembly. It is not intended to aid in the interpretation of legislation or to serve as a source of legislative intent.

Act No. 170 (H.578). Motor vehicles; insurance

An act relating to proof of financial responsibility

This act repeals a conviction for operating without financial responsibility as one of the bases for the Commissioner of Motor Vehicles requiring an individual to obtain proof of financial responsibility, commonly known as an SR-22 Certificate, and decreases, in certain instances, the length of time, from three years to one year, that an individual required to obtain proof of financial responsibility must carry that proof. This act also lays out the timeline for the Commissioner of Motor Vehicles to relieve individuals of obligations to carry proof of financial responsibility in accordance with the amendments to codified law made in this act.

This act also repeals 23 V.S.A. § 801(a)(1)(G), which required the use of insurance verification certificates when a ticket or citation for a moving violation was issued to an individual with five points assessed against his or her license at the time of the moving violation.
