

No. R-319. House concurrent resolution congratulating Heritage Landscapes and Patricia O'Donnell on receipt of the 2019 Landscape Architecture Firm Award.

Whereas, a top honor that the American Society of Landscape Architecture bestows is the Landscape Architecture Firm Award, and the recipient is usually a large firm with a practice focused on contemporary landscape designs, and

Whereas, in 1987, Patricia O'Donnell established Heritage Landscapes, a small Charlotte firm that also operates in Norwalk, Connecticut, and that specializes in historic preservation work, and

Whereas, Heritage Landscapes has worked on over 500 projects, both domestically and internationally, including at Shelburne Farms, and

Whereas, for this small Charlotte landscape architecture firm, focused exclusively on the historic preservation of "parks, museums, cemeteries, and other public places," the receipt of the Landscape Architecture Firm Award is an especially significant honor, now therefore be it

Resolved by the Senate and House of Representatives:

That the General Assembly congratulates Heritage Landscapes and Patricia O'Donnell on receipt of the 2019 Landscape Architecture Firm Award, and be it further
