7	Statement of purpose of bill as introduced: This bill proposes to require the
8	Secretary of Natural Resources to recommend environmental permit programs
9	that should allow for delegation of implementation, administration, and
10	enforcement to municipalities.
11	An act relating to delegation of State permitting programs to municipalities
12	It is hereby enacted by the General Assembly of the State of Vermont:
13	Sec. 1. AGENCY OF NATURAL RESOURCES REPORT ON
14	DELEGATION OF ENVIRONMENTAL PERMIT PROGRAMS
15	(a) Findings. The General Assembly finds that:
16	(1) Statute allows certain environmental permit programs to be
17	delegated to municipalities for implementation, administration, and
18	enforcement, including permitting of wastewater systems, wells, and lake
19	shoreland development.

1	(2) Delegation of environmental permitting to municipalities can result
2	in better administered and enforced permit programs that, consequently,
3	enhance the environmental and natural resource benefits and protection
4	afforded by the permit program.
5	(3) Authorizing delegation of environmental permitting to municipalities
6	is not appropriate for all State environmental permits as federal law may limit
7	delegation for some permits and as some permit programs are more
8	appropriately administered at the State level due to the nature, scale, or scope
9	of the activity.
10	(4) To better inform the General Assembly of what State environmental
11	permit programs can or should allow for delegation of implementation,
12	administration, and enforcement to municipalities, the General Assembly
13	should require the Secretary of Natural Resources to recommend
14	environmental permit programs that should allow for delegation to
15	municipalities.
16	(b) Report. On or before January 15, 2020, the Secretary of Natural
17	Resources shall submit to the House Committee on Natural Resources, Fish,
18	and Wildlife and the Senate Committee on Natural Resources and Energy a
19	report regarding delegation of environmental permitting programs to
20	municipalities. The report shall include:

1	(1) a summary of the existing environmental permit programs that may
2	be delegated to a municipality and the number of municipalities that have been
3	delegated under each permit program;
4	(2) a summary of reduced Agency of Natural Resources workload, if
5	any, resulting from delegation of environmental permitting to municipalities;
6	(3) a list of Agency of Natural Resources permitting programs that the
7	Secretary recommends as appropriate for delegation to municipalities and the
8	basis for the recommendation;
9	(4) a list of Agency of Natural Resources permit programs that the
10	Secretary recommends as not appropriate for delegation to municipalities, and
11	the basis for the recommendation;
12	(5) an estimate of the cost savings or reduced workload to the Agency of
13	Natural Resources if permit programs recommended under subdivision (3) of
14	this subsection were authorized for delegation to municipalities; and
15	(6) draft legislation that would authorize delegation of the permit
16	programs recommended under subdivision (3) of this subsection.
