Subject: General provisions; commemorative days; Dewey Day

Statement of purpose of bill as introduced: This bill proposes to designate
October 12 as Dewey Day.

An act relating to designating October 12 as Dewey Day

It is hereby enacted by the General Assembly of the State of Vermont:

Sec. 1. FINDINGS

U.S. Admiral George Dewey, the only person to attain the rank of Admiral
of the (U.S.) Navy, was born and raised in Montpelier. He was a renowned
U.S. Navy hero, whose military leadership resulted in the destruction of the
Spanish fleet in Manila Bay, the Philippines, during the Spanish-American
War of 1898. The original Dewey Day celebration occurred in Montpelier on

1 October 12, 1899. In 2018, the Governor issued an executive order
2 designating, on a one-time basis, October 12 as Dewey Day. However, it
3 would serve as a fitting memorial to Admiral Dewey to establish an annual
4 Dewey Day.
