Statement of purpose of bill as introduced: This bill proposes to require  
individuals enrolled in the Medicaid program with incomes between 100 and  
138 percent of the federal poverty level to pay the maximum amount of co-  
payments for their health care services as are allowed under federal law. It  
would also increase the amount of financial assistance available to income-  
eligible individuals enrolled in health insurance plans offered through the  
Vermont Health Benefit Exchange.
