Subject: Education; public schools; holidays; date of the biennial elections

Statement of purpose of bill as introduced: This bill proposes to create a public school holiday on the date of the biennial elections under the Vermont Constitution.

An act relating to creating a public school holiday on the date of the biennial elections under the Vermont Constitution

It is hereby enacted by the General Assembly of the State of Vermont:

Sec. 1. 16 V.S.A. § 1072 is amended to read:

§ 1072. LEGAL HOLIDAYS

(a) All conditions of employment relating to legal holidays, including decisions such as the closing or opening of schools and compensation for work performed on a holiday, shall be proper matters for collective bargaining pursuant to chapter 57 of this title.

(b) The date of the biennial elections, as specified in Chapter II, Section 43 of the Vermont Constitution, shall be a holiday for public schools.
