9	It is hereby enacted by the General Assembly of the State of Vermont:
10	Sec. 1. ELIMINATION OF VERMONT'S SALES AND USE TAX
11	(a) The Joint Fiscal Office shall contract with one or more outside
12	consultants to conduct a study of the economic impacts of eliminating
13	Vermont's sales and use tax. The study shall consider the direct and indirect
14	effects to the State economy of eliminating the tax, and shall also consider the
15	administrative savings, both to government and the private sector. The study
16	shall include a prediction of how Vermont's economy without a sales tax
17	might eventually make up for lost sales tax revenue, and the study shall make
18	recommendations of how to implement a transition to the elimination of the
19	sales tax.
