Subject: Executive; State officers and employees; bias training

Statement of purpose of bill as introduced: This bill proposes to require all State employees to attend a four-hour in-person implicit bias training course within 90 days of being hired by the State, and to attend a two-hour in-person implicit bias training course at least every two years thereafter.
