Subject: Court procedure; treatment court; study committee

Statement of purpose of bill as introduced: This bill proposes to: 1) establish
a study committee to analyze the potential impact of a drug treatment docket in
Windham County with membership drawn from the Department of State's
Attorneys and Sheriffs, the Office of the Defender General, Windham County
law enforcement, the Center for Restorative Justice, Health Care and
Rehabilitation Services of Vermont, and Turning Point of Windham County,
and to require the committee to report to the General Assembly on or before
January 15, 2020 with its analysis of the efficacy of such a drug treatment
docket and a recommendation for legislative action; and 2) establish a drug
treatment docket in Windham County to take effect upon the recommendation
of the study committee established in the act.
