Statement of purpose of bill as introduced: This bill proposes to require the  
Director of the Office of Professional Regulation to adopt rules that will  
provide a uniform process for the Office to assess a license applicant's  
professional credentials earned outside the United States in order to determine  
how those credentials compare to the requirements for licensure in professions  
attached to the Office that do not otherwise address the verification and  
recognition of such credentials.

1 It is hereby enacted by the General Assembly of the State of Vermont:

5 § 137. UNIFORM PROCESS FOR FOREIGN CREDENTIAL

6 VERIFICATION

7 (a) The Director shall adopt rules that prescribe a process for the Director  
8 to assess the equivalence of an applicant's professional credentials earned  
9 outside the United States as compared to State licensing requirements for those  
10 professions attached to the Office that do not have laws addressing the  
11 verification and recognition of such credentials.

12 (b) Any determination of equivalence by the Director under this section  
13 shall be recorded in the applicant's licensing file and shall be binding upon the  
14 relevant State board or regulatory program.

15 (c) In administering this section, the Director may rely upon third-party  
16 credential verification services. The cost of such services shall be paid by the  
17 applicant.

18 (d) The provisions relating to preliminary license denials set forth in  
19 subsection 129(e) of this subchapter shall apply to a license application that is  
20 preliminarily denied for nonequivalence under this section.

1       Sec. 2. TRANSITIONAL PROVISION; RULE ADOPTION

2           The Director of the Office of Professional Regulation shall adopt rules in  
3       accordance with Sec. 1 of this act so that those rules are finally adopted on or  
4       before July 1, 2020, unless that deadline is extended by the Legislative  
5       Committee on Administrative Rules pursuant to 3 V.S.A. § 843(c).

6       Sec. 3. EFFECTIVE DATE

7           This act shall take effect on passage.
