filed with the Commissioner of Motor Vehicles, and shall be maintained and

8	Sec. 2 (proof of financial responsibility contingent upon regional adoption)
9	shall take effect if and when five northeastern states require that insurance
10	identification cards include machine-readable technology. As used in this
11	subsection, "northeastern states" means the New England states, Pennsylvania
12	New York, and New Jersey.
