Subject: Human services; substance use disorder; involuntary commitment;
addiction treatment center

Statement of purpose of bill as introduced: This bill proposes to: (1) enable
qualified persons, such as a physician or relative, to request a court order
requiring a person to be civilly committed and treated involuntarily for a
substance use disorder; and (2) authorize the court to involuntarily commit a
person to an addiction treatment center who it finds has a substance use
disorder and a likelihood of serious harm to self or others as a result of the
substance use disorder.
