Subject: Human services; Department of Disabilities, Aging, and Independent

Living; long-term care facilities; receivership

Statement of purpose of bill as introduced: This bill proposes to make modifications to the laws regarding the State’s regulation of long-term care facilities by: (1) authorizing the Department of Disabilities, Aging, and Independent Living to take immediate enforcement action to eliminate a condition that can be reasonably expected to cause mental harm to residents or staff; (2) adding a definition of “insolvent” to be applied in the context of the regulation of long-term care facilities; and (3) prohibiting any actions taken by a court-appointed temporary receiver from being used by a long-term care facility in support of its opposition to the Department’s request for a receivership.
