11	Statement of purpose of bill as introduced: This bill proposes to require
12	pedestrians to wear reflective material or carry a lamp, or both, when walking
13	along a highway without a sidewalk.

15	It is hereby enacted by the General Assembly of the State of Vermont:
16	Sec. 1. 23 V.S.A. § 1055 is amended to read:
17	§ 1055. PEDESTRIANS ON ROADWAYS; <u>EQUIPMENT</u>
18	(a) Where public sidewalks are provided, no person may walk along or
19	upon an adjacent roadway.

1	(b) Where public sidewalks are not provided, any pedestrian walking along
2	and upon a highway shall, when practicable,:
3	(1) walk only on the left side of the roadway or its shoulder facing the
4	direction of possible oncoming traffic, when practicable; and
5	(2) wear reflective material with a surface area totaling at least
6	200 square inches or carry a lamp that emits a white light visible from a
7	distance of at least 150 feet under normal atmospheric conditions, or both, so
8	as to be clearly visible to possible oncoming traffic during the period from
9	30 minutes after sunset to 30 minutes before sunrise.
10	Sec. 2. EFFECTIVE DATE
11	This act shall take effect on July 1, 2020.
