10	Statement of purpose of bill as introduced: This bill proposes to require the

15	regulations and, on or before November 15, 2020, to report its findings and
16	recommendations to the House and Senate Committees on Education.

An act relating to expanding access to information about special education

1	It is hereby enacted by the General Assembly of the State of Vermont:
2	Sec. 1. COMPREHENSIVE SPECIAL EDUCATION DATABASE;
3	REPORT
4	The Agency of Education shall explore the possibility of making available
5	to school district and supervisory union employees and parents of children with
6	disabilities a service that provides a comprehensive special education database
7	of searchable case law, federal policy and guidance, and statutes and
8	regulations. The Agency shall determine the cost of this service and whether it
9	can be funded through federal programs or grants. On or before November 15,
10	2020, the Agency shall report its findings and recommendations to the House
11	and Senate Committees on Education.
12	Sec. 2. EFFECTIVE DATE
13	This act shall take effect on passage.
