Subject: Health; mental health; mobile response services; pilot

Statement of purpose of bill as introduced: This bill proposes to establish and
fund a mental health mobile response unit pilot program in the city of Rutland.

An act relating to establishing a mental health mobile response unit pilot
program in the city of Rutland

It is hereby enacted by the General Assembly of the State of Vermont:

Sec. 1. PILOT; MENTAL HEALTH RESPONSE UNIT

(a) In fiscal year 2022, the General Assembly shall appropriate
\$400,000.00 from the General Fund to the Department of Mental Health for
the purpose of implementing a pilot program in the city of Rutland that
provides additional supports for mobile response and stabilization services to

1 children, youths, and families. Appropriated monies shall be used to pay for
2 program staff and services that support direct, in-person responses to family
3 crises, such as interventions for children or youths and their families, before
4 emotional and behavioral difficulties escalate.

5 (b) On or before January 15, 2022, the Department of Mental Health shall
6 submit a report to the House Committee on Health Care and to the Senate
7 Committee on Health and Welfare regarding the results of the pilot program
8 established in this section and any related recommendations, including whether
9 the pilot program should be considered for statewide adoption.

10 Sec. 2. EFFECTIVE DATE

11 This act shall take effect on July 1, 2020.
