1	(1) "Intimate areas" means the genitals, pubic area, buttocks, or female
2	breast of a person.
3	(2) "Sexual conduct" shall have the same meaning as in section 2821 of

5	(b) No person shall knowingly transmit by electronic means visual material
6	<u>that:</u>
7	(1) depicts:
8	(A) any person engaging in sexual conduct or with the person's
9	intimate parts exposed; or
10	(B) covered genitals of a male person that are in a discernibly turgid

12	(2) is not sent at the request of or with the express consent of the
