9	Statement of purpose of bill as introduced: This bill proposes to impose a tax		
10	on any telecommunications service provider that allows a robocall to be

12	Internet Protocol service when that robocall is prohibited pursuant to the		
13	Telemarketing and Consumer Fraud and Abuse Prevention Act, 15 U.S.C.		
14	chapter 87 and applicable rules. The tax shall be in the amount of \$1.00 for		
15	each federally prohibited call completed through its network, irrespective of		
16	whether the intended recipient answers. For purposes of this bill, a robocall		
17	shall include an artificial, prerecorded, or human voice. In addition, this bill		
18	requires telecommunications providers to offer call mitigation technology to		
19	Vermont customers, upon request, at no additional charge.
