8	Statement of purpose of bill as introduced: This bill proposes to amend
9	2 V.S.A. § 266 (prohibited conduct) within the chapter of law regulating
10	lobbying in order to prohibit gifts to legislators from lobbyists, lobbyist
11	employers, and lobbying firms. Within the chapter, "gift" is generally defined
12	in 2 V.S.A. § 261(6) as anything of value, tangible or intangible, that is
13	bestowed for less than adequate consideration. Accordingly, this bill would
14	prohibit a lobbying entity from providing to a legislator food, beverages, or
15	any other item unless the legislator pays that lobbying entity for the actual
16	value of that item.
