7	Sec. 1. PURPOSE
8	This proposal would amend the Constitution of the State of Vermont
9	specifically to provide that each individual has a right to privacy, including the
10	right to keep personal information private; to communicate with others
11	privately; and to make decisions concerning his or her body. The proposal
12	shall not be construed to modify the public's right of access to public records
13	and open meetings as provided by law.
14	Sec. 2. Article 22 of Chapter I of the Vermont Constitution is added to read:
15	Article 22. [RIGHT TO PRIVACY]
16	That each individual has a right to privacy that shall not be infringed
17	without the showing of a compelling State interest. This right includes the
18	individual's right to keep personal information private; to communicate with
19	others privately; and to make decisions concerning his or her body.
20	Sec. 3. EFFECTIVE DATE
21	The amendment set forth in Sec. 2 shall become a part of the Constitution
22	of the State of Vermont on the first Tuesday after the first Monday of
