An act relating to emissions inspections

It is hereby enacted by the General Assembly of the State of Vermont:

Sec. 1. 23 V.S.A. § 1222(a) is amended to read:

- (a) Except for school buses, which shall be inspected as prescribed in section 1282 of this title, and motor buses as defined in subdivision 4(17) of this title, which shall be inspected twice during the calendar year at six-month intervals, all motor vehicles registered in this State shall be inspected undergo a safety inspection once each year and all motor vehicles that are registered in this State and are 10 model years old or less shall undergo an emissions or on board diagnostic (OBD) systems inspection once each year as applicable. Any motor vehicle, trailer, or semi-trailer not currently inspected in this State shall be inspected within 15 days following the date of its registration in the State of Vermont.
- Sec. 2. RULEMAKING; IMMEDIATE IMPLEMENTATION
- (a) Within 14 days after the effective date of this section, the

 Commissioner of Motor Vehicles shall file with the Secretary of State a

 proposed amended rule governing vehicle inspections in this State (Periodic

 Inspection Manual) that is consistent with amendments to 23 V.S.A. § 1222 in

 Sec. 1 of this act, with the effect that no motor vehicle that is more than

10 model years old will be required to undergo an emissions or on board diagnostic (OBD) systems inspection.

- (b) As soon as practicable after the effective date of this section, the

 Commissioner shall update the content of inspections conducted through the

 Automated Vehicle Inspection Program to exclude any requirements of the

 current Periodic Inspection Manual that are inconsistent with the amendments

 to 23 V.S.A. § 1222 in Sec. 1 of this act, with the effect that no motor vehicle
 that is more than 10 model years old will be required to undergo an emissions

 or OBD systems inspection.
- (c) In the event that the Commissioner cannot update the content of inspections conducted through the Automated Vehicle Inspection Program in accordance with subsection (b) of this section within 30 days after the effective date of this section, the Commissioner shall, within 30 days after the effective date of this section, develop and implement a temporary work-around to ensure that no motor vehicle that is more than 10 model years old will be required to undergo an emissions or OBD systems inspection.

Sec. 3. EFFECTIVE DATE

This act shall take effect on passage.
