13	(a) The Board may file a civil action for injunctive relief in Washington
14	County Superior Court to enforce a provision of this chapter or a rule adopted
15	by the Board under this chapter. The court shall award the Board its costs and
16	reasonable attorney's fees in the event that the Board prevails in an action
17	under this subsection.
18	(b) A person who violates the provisions of section 7059 of this title shall
19	be imprisoned not more than one year or fined not more than \$10,000.00, or

(c) An aggrieved individual may maintain an action in Superior Court for
damages, injunctive relief, costs, and attorney's fees against any person who
intentionally or with gross negligence violates any provision of, or rules
adopted under, section 7059 or subsection 7055(b) of this title.
(d) A person who violates a provision of a Board rule establishing outage
reporting protocols shall be subject to an administrative penalty of \$25,000.00
for each day of noncompliance and proceeded against as provided in the
Vermont Administrative Procedure Act established under 3 V.S.A. chapter 25
As used in this subsection, "person" means an originating carrier that provides
voice service as defined by Board rule.
