14	A person may An individual under 21 years of age shall not operate or ride
15	upon a motorcycle upon <u>on</u> a highway unless he or she properly wears
16	protective headgear a helmet of a type that conforms to the federal Motor
17	Vehicle Safety Standards contained in 49 C.F.R. § 571.218, as may be
18	amended. The requirement of this section shall not apply to occupants of fully

enclosed autocycles or while an individual is participating in a parade for

- which a permit or other official authorization has been granted by a local
- 2 governing body or other governmental authority.

- 4 This act shall take effect on July 1, 2020.
