11	It is hereby enacted by the General Assembly of the State of Vermont:
12	Sec. 1. 23 V.S.A. § 1252 is amended to read:
13	§ 1252. ISSUANCE OF PERMITS FOR SIRENS OR COLORED LAMPS,
14	OR BOTH; USE OF AMBER LAMPS
15	(a) Siren and signal lamp permits. When satisfied as to the condition and
16	use of the vehicle, the Commissioner shall issue and may revoke, for cause,
17	permits for sirens or colored signal lamps in the following manner:
18	* * *

(7) One green signal lamp may be authorized for all wreckers, provided
that the Commissioner shall prohibit the use of the green signal lamp when the
wrecker is not recovering another vehicle or responding to an emergency.
(b) Amber signal lamps. Amber signal lamps shall be used on road
maintenance vehicles, service vehicles, and wreckers and shall be used on all
registered snow removal equipment when in use removing snow on public
highways and the amber lamps shall be mounted so as to be visible from all
sides of the motor vehicle. A vehicle equipped with an amber signal lamp may
not be issued a permit for the installation and use of a siren.
Sec. 2. EFFECTIVE DATE
This act shall take effect on July 1, 2020.
