Statement of purpose of bill as introduced: This bill proposes to exempt
attorneys who are 80 years of age and older from the fee to renew their license.

An act relating to an exemption from attorney renewal fees

It is hereby enacted by the General Assembly of the State of Vermont:

Sec. 1. PURPOSE

The purpose of this act is to provide attorneys 80 years of age and older
with the same exemption from license renewal fees as is provided to the
majority of all other licensees in the State.

Sec. 2. 32 V.S.A. § 1111 is amended to read:

§ 1111. EXEMPTION FROM LICENSING RENEWAL FEES; PERSONS
~~OVER~~ 80 AND OLDER

1 Notwithstanding any provision of law to the contrary, licensees who are
2 80 years of age ~~or~~ and older shall be exempt from payment of a renewal fee
3 required under any provision of Title 26 or any of the following statutes:

4 (1) 18 V.S.A. chapter 46 (nursing home administrators);

5 (2) 31 V.S.A. chapter ~~3 of Title 31~~ 21 (boxing);

6 (3) 4 V.S.A. chapter ~~203 of this title (auctioneers)~~ 23 (attorneys).

7 Sec. 3. EFFECTIVE DATE

8 This act shall take effect on July 1, 2020.
