Statement of purpose of bill as introduced: This bill proposes to limit the  
amount of a beneficiary's out-of-pocket expenses for prescription insulin drugs  
under a health insurance plan to not more than \$100.00 per 30-day supply.

An act relating to limiting out-of-pocket expenses for prescription insulin  
drugs

It is hereby enacted by the General Assembly of the State of Vermont:

Sec. 1. 8 V.S.A. § 4089i is amended to read:

§ 4089i. PRESCRIPTION DRUG COVERAGE

\* \* \*

(h) A health insurance or other health benefit plan offered by a health  
insurer or pharmacy benefit manager shall limit a beneficiary's out-of-pocket  
expenditures for prescription insulin drugs to not more than \$100.00 per 30-  
day supply, regardless of the amount or type of insulin needed to fill the  
beneficiary's prescription.
