Statement of purpose of bill as introduced: This bill proposes to allow a  
manufacturer of vinous beverages to serve wine by the glass at a fourth-class  
license location on the licensee's manufacturing premises.

An act relating to allowing fourth-class license locations to serve wine by  
the glass

It is hereby enacted by the General Assembly of the State of Vermont:

Sec. 1. 7 V.S.A. § 224 is amended to read:

§ 224. FOURTH-CLASS LICENSES

\* \* \*

(b) At each licensed location, a fourth-class licensee may sell by the  
unopened container or distribute by the glass, with or without charge, alcoholic  
beverages manufactured by the licensee.
