| 13 | (a) In fiscal year 2020, \$16,000,000.00 shall be appropriated from the |
| 14 | Coronavirus Relief Fund to the Agency of Administration for the purpose of |
| 15 | issuing grants to units of local government to reimburse eligible COVID-19 |
| 16 | expenses incurred on or before December 30, 2020, including hazard pay, |
| 17 | supplies and equipment, sanitation, facility alterations, overtime compensation, |
| 18 | redirection of staff for first-response needs, and any other eligible COVID-19 |
| 19 | expenses not covered by other funding sources, including funding provided by |

| 1 | the Federal Emergency Management Agency. To be eligible for |
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| 2 | reimbursement under this section, COVID-19 expenses shall be consistent with |
| 3 | the uses authorized in section 5001 of the Coronavirus Aid, Relief, and |
| 4 | Economic Security Act, Pub. L. No.116-136 (the CARES Act), as may be |
| 5 | amended, and any guidance or regulations issued pursuant to that section. |
| 6 | (b) The Secretary of Administration or designee shall develop grant |
| 7 | guidelines for determining eligibility of COVID-19 expenses and requirements |
| 8 | for reimbursement for units of local government. |
| 9 | (c) From the amount appropriated to the Agency of Administration under |

| 11 | (1) \$14,850,000.00 to Vermont cities and towns in grants for |
