Joint Senate Resolution Adopted on the Part of the Senate

J.R.S. 22.

Joint Senate resolution of the following title was offered, read and adopted on the part of the Senate, and is as follows:

By Senator Ashe,

J.R.S. 22. Joint resolution relating to weekend adjournment.

Resolved by the Senate and House of Representatives:

That when the two Houses adjourn on Friday, April 5, 2019, it be to meet again no later than Tuesday, April 9, 2019.

Bills Introduced

Third Readings Ordered

H. 58.
