A message was received from His Excellency, the Governor, by Ms. Brittney L. Wilson, Secretary of Civil and Military Affairs, as follows:

Mr. President:

I am directed by the Governor to inform the Senate that on the twenty-eighth day of April, 2020 he approved and signed bills originating in the Senate of the following titles:

S. 114. An act relating to the emergency judicial response to the COVID-19 public health emergency.

S. 316. An act relating to execution of wills during an emergency.

S. 326. An act relating to the State Advisory Panel on Special Education.

S. 340. An act relating to FY 2020 interfund borrowing authority.

S. 341. An act relating to disclosure of tax information to facilitate the provision of Pandemic Unemployment Assistance benefits.
