I am directed to inform the Senate that:

The House has considered a bill originating in the Senate of the following title:

S. 347. An act relating to suspension of time frames for civil license suspension hearings for certain DUI offenses.

And has passed the same in concurrence.

The House has considered joint resolution originating in the Senate of the following title:

J.R.S. 56. Joint resolution relating to weekend adjournment.

And has adopted the same in concurrence.

The House has considered Senate proposal of amendment to the following House bill:

H. 948. An act relating to temporary municipal proceedings provisions in response to the COVID-19 outbreak.

And has severally concurred therein.
