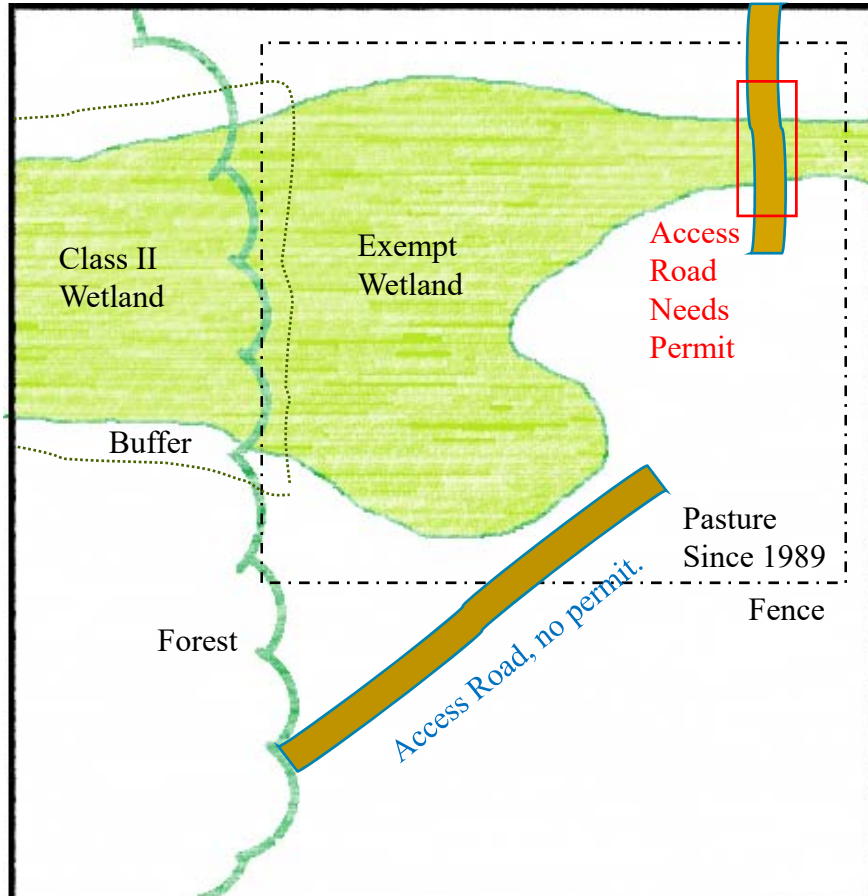


Current Wetland Rule Farming Exemption



Exemption Expiration: whenever the area is no longer used to grow food or crops or in ordinary rotation.

Expired exemption areas would still need to meet the Class II wetland definition to require permits.

Many wet agricultural soils were historically drained and would not be Class II wetland.

Also Exempt (allowed use under Rules): Maintenance of existing structures and facilities. Non-substantial expansion or modification of existing structures or facilities.

E.g. when in wetland or wetland buffer you may:

- ✓Fix an existing road
- ✓Keep using your barn, silo, stables
- ✓Improve manure pit in its existing footprint
