6	Statement of purpose of bill as introduced: This bill proposes to provide
7	support for the workforce development efforts of Salvation Farms.
8	An act relating to supporting workforce development at Salvation Farms
9	It is hereby enacted by the General Assembly of the State of Vermont:
10	Sec. 1. FINDINGS
11	The General Assembly finds:
12	(1) Salvation Farms is a tax-exempt nonprofit organization that provides
13	job readiness training in food handling and light manufacturing to Vermonters
14	with barriers to employment, including recovery from substance abuse, past
15	incarceration, physical or mental disability, homelessness, age, and refugee
16	<u>status.</u>
17	(2) Salvation Farms began gleaning in 2004, collecting surplus crops
18	from farms to distribute to Vermonters in need. In 2008, it built the Vermont
19	Food Bank's gleaning program and, in 2012, founded the Vermont Gleaning
20	Collective. Since its inception, the organization has supported the distribution

1	of more than five million food servings to food shelves, Meals on Wheels,
2	affordable and senior housing, and a variety of care facilities.
3	(3) In 2016, Salvation Farms began operating its food hub, the Vermont
4	Commodity Program, where it provides job readiness training relating to
5	collecting, preparing, and distributing food throughout its distribution network.
6	(4) Support from the State of Vermont will allow Salvation Farms to
7	relocate from its current headquarters in Winooski to a larger, permanent
8	location and allow the organization to expand its mission, provide additional
9	job readiness training, and distribute more Vermont-grown food to those in
10	need.
11	Sec. 2. APPROPRIATION
12	It is the intent of the General Assembly:
13	(1) in fiscal year 2020, to appropriate funding to Salvation Farms for
14	planning and buildout of infrastructure needed to move its job readiness
15	training program and food hub into a new permanent location; and
16	(2) to provide ongoing funding support to Salvation Farms to support its
17	job readiness training program.
18	Sec. 3. EFFECTIVE DATE
19	This act shall take effect on July 1, 2019.
