2	(2) "Petroleum or heating fuel product" means motor fuels, liquefied
3	petroleum gas, fuel oil, kerosene, and wood pellets used for heating or cooking
4	purposes.
5	(3) "Petroleum or heating fuel-related business" means any producer,
6	supplier, wholesaler, distributor, or retail seller of any petroleum or heating
7	fuel product.
8	(b) It is an unfair and deceptive act and practice in commerce and a
9	violation of section 2453 of this title for any petroleum or heating fuel-related
10	business <u>:</u>
11	(1) during a market emergency, or seven days prior thereto, to sell or
12	offer to sell any petroleum product or heating fuel product for an amount that
13	represents an unconscionably high price; or
14	(2) from October 15 through April 15, to impose a delivery surcharge of
15	fee, or otherwise enhance the normal delivery price, to deliver a petroleum
16	product or heating fuel product to a residential consumer on a holiday or
17	weekend.
