5	Statement of purpose of bill as introduced: This bill proposes to create a
6	COVID-19 Manufacturing Grant Program.
7	An act relating to creating a COVID-19 Manufacturing Grant Program
8	It is hereby enacted by the General Assembly of the State of Vermont:
9	Sec. 1. COVID-19 MANUFACTURING GRANT PROGRAM
10	(a) Purpose.
11	(1) The purpose of this section is to establish a COVID-19
12	Manufacturing Grant Program to assist Vermont manufacturing companies
13	in quickly accelerating production of items necessary to respond to the
14	COVID-19 outbreak.
15	(2) The Program shall provide grants to manufacturers to increase
16	capacity in current operations and to pivot production to build and assemble
17	critical need items that are currently or expected to be in short supply,
18	including:
19	(A) personal protection equipment, including N95 respirators,
20	surgical masks, cloth masks, and isolation gowns;

1	(B) respiratory care equipment, including ventilators;
2	(C) medical devices; and
3	(D) other items identified by the State Emergency Operations Center
4	as necessary for workplace and community safety.
5	(b) Eligible recipients.
6	(1) To be eligible for a grant, an applicant shall meet the following
7	<u>criteria:</u>
8	(A) the applicant has demonstrated manufacturing capacity;
9	(B) the facility where the applicant manufactures qualifying products
10	is located in Vermont; and
11	(C) the applicant and any affiliated businesses under common
12	ownership or control, whether within or outside this State, have 500 or fewer
13	employees or otherwise meet a Small Business Administration classification of
14	small business or small manufacturer; and
15	(D) the applicant can demonstrate the ability to produce the product
16	for resale or supply at a price that is competitive with other suppliers of the
17	same product or a reasonable substitute.
18	(2) The Agency shall give preference for grant awards to applicants who
19	demonstrate the potential for developing new lines of business that are
20	sustainable over the long term.

1	(c) Eligible use of funds. A recipient may use grant funds for the
2	following:
3	(1) purchase and set up of production equipment;
4	(2) expenses necessary to produce critical care items;
5	(3) prototyping expenses for complex medical devices; and
6	(4) training expenses to train employees in the new production process
7	and equipment.
8	(d) Amount of grants. An applicant is eligible to apply for one or more
9	grants, the total of which shall not exceed \$20,000.00 per recipient.
10	(e) Administration of grants.
11	(1) The Agency of Commerce and Community Development shall
12	administer the grants in coordination with the Vermont Manufacturing
13	Extension Center and the Innovation Center at the University of Vermont.
14	(2) The Agency, the Centers, and regional development corporations
15	shall publicize information about the Program and the application process.
16	(3) The Agency may adopt additional policies and procedures
17	concerning the application process, eligibility, and use of funds, as it
18	determines is necessary to administer the Program.
19	(f) Reporting:
20	(1) The Agency shall report to the General Assembly bi-weekly during
21	the pandemic crisis on the number of grants awarded, the projected and actual

1	production volumes, and the number of entities receiving the products being
2	produced.
3	(2) The Agency shall submit a final report on the Grant program on or
4	before December 15, 2020.
5	(g) Funding. The Agency of Commerce and Community Development
6	may use not more than \$500,000.00 to award grants pursuant to this act using
7	funds appropriated to it for the New Remote Worker Grant Program created in
8	2018 Acts and Resolves No. 197, Sec. 1, as amended by 2019 Acts and
9	Resolves No. 80, Sec. 15 and the New Worker Relocation Incentive Program
10	created by 2019 Acts and Resolves No. 80, Sec. 12.
11	Sec. 2. EFFECTIVE DATE
12	This act shall take effect on passage.
