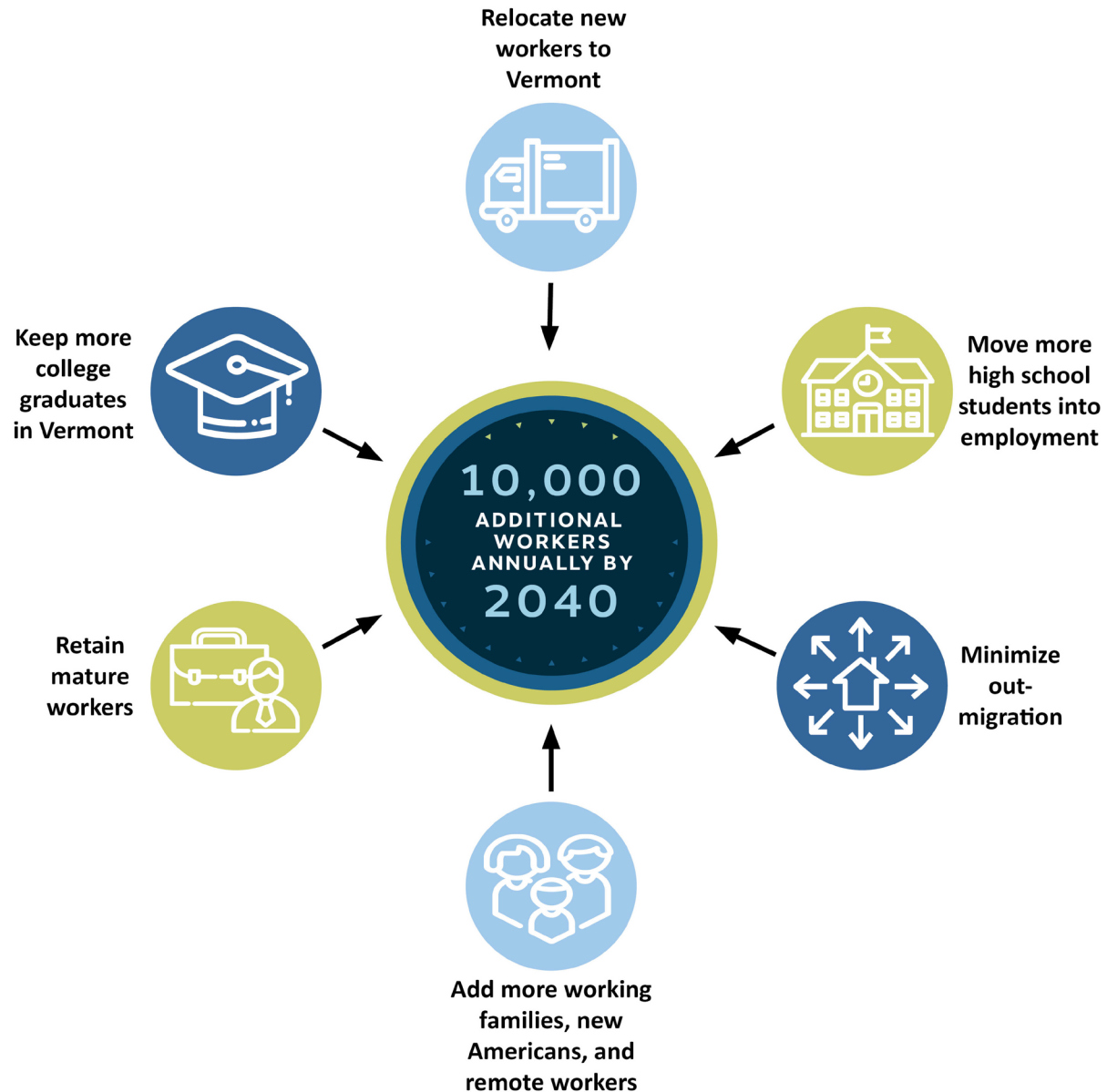



Tourism

- Vermont's economy is dependent upon tourism (approximately 6% of GDP)
- 13.5 million average annual visitors
- \$2.9 billion in visitor spending
- \$375 million in tax revenue generated
- 32,484 jobs



Our Recommendations

- Adjustment to alcohol-related regulations
 - Establish licensee pricing
 - Allow licensees to purchase spirits with a credit card
 - Extend the current pandemic-allowed liquor-to-go sales to allow for a wind-down period of the service
- Require consent language to ensure restaurants have approval over inclusion on third-party delivery app
- Reform Vermont's short-term rental regulations (STR), including the establishment of a STR registry

Manufacturing

- 29,850 jobs (9.5% of all employment)
- About \$2.8 billion or 9% of the state's GDP
- Each manufacturing job supports an additional 1.6 jobs
- Each advanced manufacturing job supports as many as 4 jobs in other industries
