5 § 271. MANUFACTURER’S OR RECTIFIER’S LICENSE

6 (a)(1) The Board of Liquor and Lottery may grant a manufacturer’s or  
7 rectifier’s license upon application and payment of the fee provided in section  
8 204 of this title that permits the license holder to operate a facility that  
9 ~~manufacture~~ manufactures or ~~rectify~~ rectifies:

10 (1)(A) malt beverages;

11 (2)(B) vinous beverages and fortified wines; or

12 (3)(C) spirits and fortified wines.

13 (2) A manufacturer or rectifier shall obtain a separate license for each  
14 facility at which it manufactures or rectifies alcoholic beverages.

16 (d)(1) The Board of Liquor and Lottery may grant to a licensed  
17 manufacturer or rectifier a first-class license or ~~a first- and~~ a third-class license,  
18 or both, permitting the licensee to sell alcoholic beverages to the public at an  
19 establishment located at the manufacturer’s ~~premises~~ or rectifier’s licensed  
20 facility, provided the manufacturer or rectifier owns or has direct control over  
21 that establishment.

1           (2) ~~For a~~ A licensed manufacturer of malt beverages, ~~the premises of the~~  
2 ~~manufacturer may include~~ may operate up to two licensed establishments  
3 pursuant to this subsection that are located at the licensed manufacturing  
4 facility or on the property that is owned by the licensee and is contiguous ~~real~~  
5 ~~estate of~~ with the license holder parcel of land on which the licensed  
6 manufacturing facility is located, provided the manufacturer owns or has direct  
7 control over both establishments.

8           (3) Notwithstanding subdivisions (1) and (2) of this subsection, a  
9 manufacturer or rectifier that, on July 1, 2019, is operating at a location  
10 separate from its licensed manufacturing facility an establishment for which it  
11 was granted a first-class license or a third-class license, or both, before July 1,  
12 2019 may continue to operate that establishment, and the local control  
13 commissioners and the Board may annually renew the licenses in effect for  
14 that establishment on July 1, 2019.

15           (e) The Board of Liquor and Lottery may grant a licensed manufacturer of  
16 malt beverages a second-class license permitting the licensee to sell alcoholic  
17 beverages to the public anywhere on the ~~manufacturer's~~ premises of the  
18 licensed manufacturing facility.

19           (f)(1) A licensed manufacturer or rectifier may serve alcoholic beverages  
20 with or without charge at an event held ~~on the premises of the licensee~~ at the  
21 licensed manufacturing or rectifying facility or at a location on ~~the~~ property

1 that is owned by the licensee and is contiguous real estate of the licensee with  
2 the parcel of land on which the licensed facility is located, provided the  
3 licensee at least five days before the event gives the Division written notice of  
4 the event, including details required by the Division.
