13	highway right-of-way for not more than 21 days if:
14	(i) it announces a civic campaign, drive, or event;
15	(ii) the bottom of the banner is not less than 14 feet 6 inches above
16	the surface of the highway;
17	(iii) it is securely fastened with breakaway fasteners; and
18	(iv) it does not advertise a business.
19	(B) As used in this subdivision (18), "banner" means a sign that is
20	constructed of soft cloth or fabric or flexible material such as vinyl or plastic
21	<u>cardboard.</u>

8	494(1), (2), (3), (6), (7), (10), (14), and (17) of this title.
