3	(a)(1) The Secretary of State shall provide on the online database set forth
4	in section 2906 of this chapter digital access to the form that he or she provides
5	for any report required by this chapter. Digital access shall enable any person
6	required to file a report under this chapter to file the report by completing and
7	submitting the report to the Secretary of State online.
8	(2) The Secretary of State shall maintain on the online database all
