Scope of ELC Grant

- The Health Department is currently spending approximately \$1 million a week on the Health Operations Center COVID-19 response
- This ELC grant will cover the continuation of this response:
 - Specimen collection/Testing (e.g. testing staff, specimen collection, collection site, software for results)
 - Laboratory services (e.g. staff, equipment, supplies and software)
 - Contact tracing
 - Health Operations Center
 - Data analysis/surveillance
 - Communications/outreach
 - Health disparities

Health Equity

- Support community outreach, education and translation services
 - Add Health Equity Technical Advisor to HOC staff
 - AALV Translation Services \$66,000
 - Community Provider Grants (8 at \$50k x 2) \$640,000
 - Translation (\$256 per doc x 8 docs x 11 languages x 30 months) \$675,840
 - Gender/Race Equity Training \$15,000

Braiding funding sources for the response

- This ELC grant is a continuation of the prior ELC funding that the Department has already received
- The proposed budget depends on the \$17.3 million in CRF funding to carry response through December
- ELC allows flexibility for proposed budget to shift in the future as needs and priorities change
- Restricted from paying for insurance-reimbursable testing
 - We are working on a payment mechanism for insurance reimbursement to ensure we leverage all available funding
