1	TO THE HOUSE OF REPRESENTATIVES:
2	The Committee on Human Services to which was referred House Bill No.
3	424 entitled "An act relating to the Interstate Compact on the Placement of
4	Children" respectfully reports that it has considered the same and recommends
5	that the bill be amended as follows:
6	First: In Sec. 1, repeal, by striking out ", subchapter 1"
7	Second: In Sec. 2, 33 V.S.A. chapter 59, subchapter 1, in the section
8	designation, by striking out ", subchapter 1" and, following section 5918, by
9	adding the following:
10	Subchapter 2. Provisions Relating to Interstate Compact for the
11	Placement of Children
12	§ 5921. FINANCIAL RESPONSIBILITY
13	Financial responsibility for any child placed pursuant to the provisions of
14	the Interstate Compact for the Placement of Children shall be determined in
15	accordance with the provisions of section 5907 of this title. However, in the
16	event of partial or complete default of performance thereunder, the provisions
17	of this title and Title 15 also may be invoked.
18	§ 5922. AGENCY
19	This State's "government child welfare agency or child protection agency,"
20	"public child placing agency," and "central state compact office" is the
21	Department for Children and Families.

2	The officers and agencies of this State having authority to place children are
3	hereby empowered to enter into agreements with appropriate officers or
4	agencies of or in other party states pursuant to the Interstate Compact for the
5	Placement of Children. Any such agreement which contains a financial
6	commitment or imposes a financial obligation on this State or agency thereof
7	shall not be binding unless it has the approval in writing of the Secretary of the
8	Agency of Administration.
9	§ 5924. PLACEMENT OF CHILD IN ANOTHER STATE
10	The officers and agencies of this State having authority to place a child in
11	the custody of the Commissioner of the Department for Children and Families
12	may place such a child in another state. However, unless parental rights have
13	been judicially terminated any such child being placed in another state
14	pursuant to this compact shall, upon request, be given a court hearing on notice
15	to the parent or guardian with opportunity to be heard prior to his or her being
16	sent to such other state for care and the court finds that:
17	(1) equivalent facilities for the child are not available in this State;
18	(2) care in the other state is in the best interest of the child and will not
19	produce undue hardship.

1	§ 5925. EXECUTIVE HEAD
2	The term "executive head" in this State means the Secretary of the Agency
3	of Human Services. The Secretary of the Agency of Human Services is hereby
4	authorized to appoint a compact administrator in accordance with the terms of
5	section 5907 of this title.
6	Third: By striking out Sec. 3 in its entirety and inserting in lieu thereof the
7	following:
8	Sec. 3. EFFECTIVE DATES
9	(a) Secs. 1 and 2 shall take effect 18 months from the date on which the
10	Compact set forth in Sec. 2 is enacted into law by 35 states.
11	(b) This section shall take effect on passage.
