We are Richard and Claudette Kettinger. We're writing this to inform you of our opposition to H.57.

Those legislators who intend to vote on and see that this bill is passed, should be forced to personally witness an abortion of a fully viable baby. If you vote for this you will have the blood of every baby that is aborted on your hands and will stand before God just as guilty of murder as those that are performing the abortions.
