13	In recognition of the significant contribution home visiting services make

15	parenting skills; reducing child maltreatment; promoting social and emotional
16	health; improving school readiness; and promoting economic self-sufficiency,
17	the General Assembly seeks to ensure that home visiting services are available
18	to all Vermonters in need of this service.

2	<u>§ 3404. HOME VISITING SERVICES</u>
3	(a) As used in this section, "home visiting services" means regular,
4	voluntary visits with a pregnant woman or a family with a young child for the
5	purpose of providing a continuum of services that improves maternal and child
6	health; prevents child injuries, abuse, or maltreatment; promotes social and
7	emotional health; improves school readiness; reduces crime or domestic
8	violence; improves economic self-sufficiency; or enhances coordination and
9	referrals among community resources and supports, such as food, housing, and
10	transportation.
11	(b)(1) The Secretary of Human Services, in consultation with interested
12	providers of home visiting services and other stakeholders, shall develop a
13	system for the delivery of home visiting services throughout Vermont.
14	(2) The system shall address the following:
15	(A) sustainable funding for home visiting services for all Medicaid
16	families in need of home visiting services;
17	(B) home visiting services that can respond to diverse family needs;
18	(C) home visiting service provider training and supervision;
19	(D) a structure for coordinating services at the State and local levels
20	with respect to outreach efforts, family intake methods, referrals, and
